PT Census taker jobs available in the Capital Region. Every 10 years, a census of our population is conducted. The results help determine your representation in government, as well as how federal funds spent in your community on things like roads, parks, housing, schools, grants, and public safety. As a census taker, you will play a vital role in making sure that everyone is included. All census takers must be able to speak English, but bilingual skills in Spanish and other languages are needed in communities that have a large number of residents who speak a language other than English. If you have such skills, we encourage you to apply. Besides good pay, you will have flexible hours, mileage reimbursement, paid training, and the chance to work within your own community. As a census taker, you will: locate households, update address lists, explain the purpose of the census, conduct interviews with respondents, record responses on paper forms, and meet with you crew leader every day to turn in completed work and payroll forms, and to discuss your progress. Census takers usually work in their own neighborhoods or communities and must work varied hours. Some operations occur during regular daylight hours while others, which require personally interviewing respondents, mean census takers must work when people are typically at home, including evenings and weekends.
